As you know the PAC Partners have been engaged in raising funds to keep the PAC open and operating as a community arts and education venue since 2012, through an agreement with Clatsop Community College.

The Partners for the PAC are currently in negotiation with Clatsop Community College toward the purchase of the PAC. The Partners started a due diligence process in July 2018 to determine the feasibility of the long range plan to acquire the PAC. We intend to finalize a plan for the PAC by spring 2019. Acquiring the PAC and moving forward will necessitate a capital campaign to raise funds for deferred maintenance, operating costs, and to establish a sustaining fund. We feel optimistic about the process!
